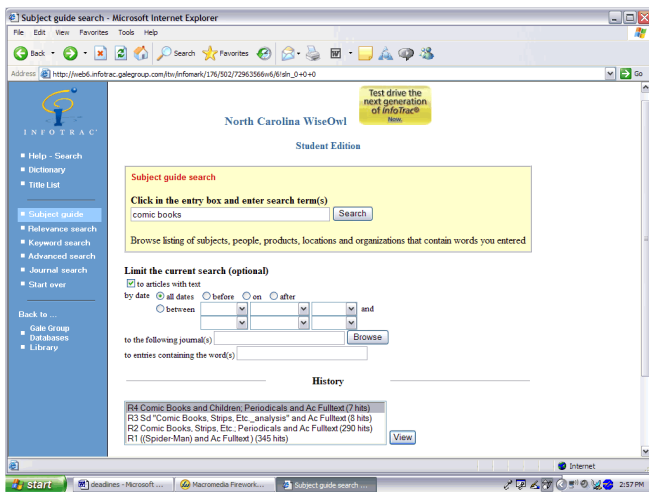


Step 4: pick the one that matches your topic the best

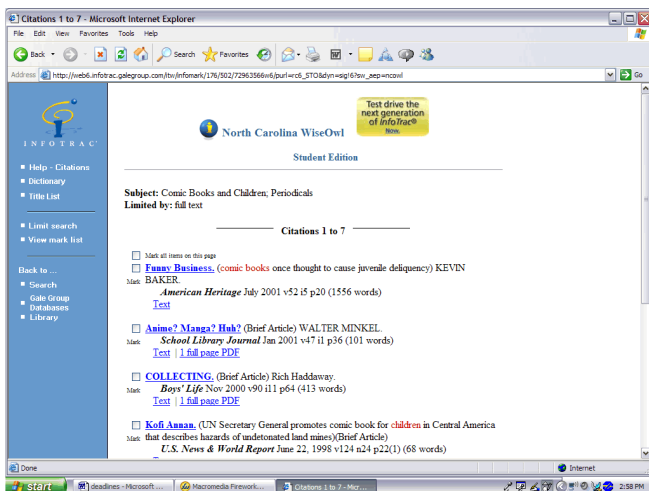
pick one that says either periodicals or newspapers.



Step 5: go to the bottom of the page where it says History

the top choice is your most recent search

click the topic and then click VIEW

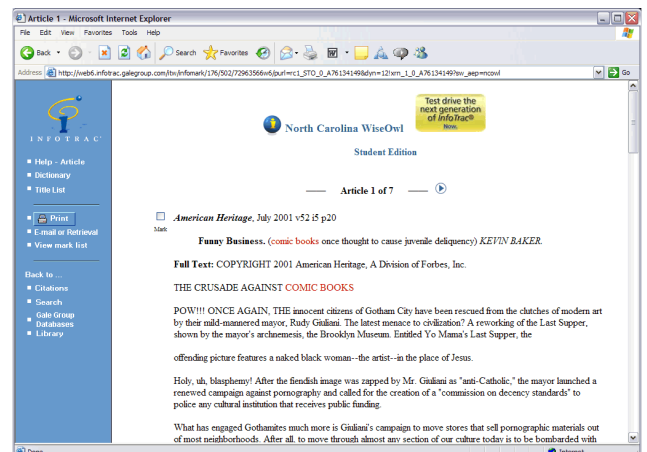


Step 6: pick the article you want to read; it should have the full text

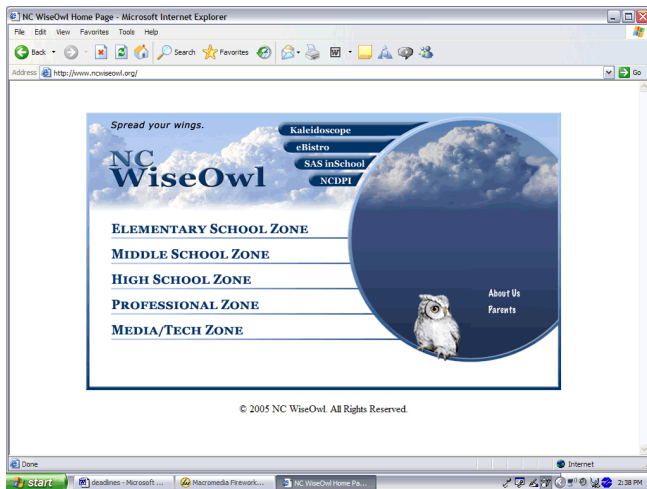
if the full text is not available and you really want that article, write down the citation and bring it to the librarians

Step 7: when you are ready to print your article, do NOT use the top tool bar or File – instead use the PRINT option on the left hand side of the page

there is also an option to e-mail the article to yourself



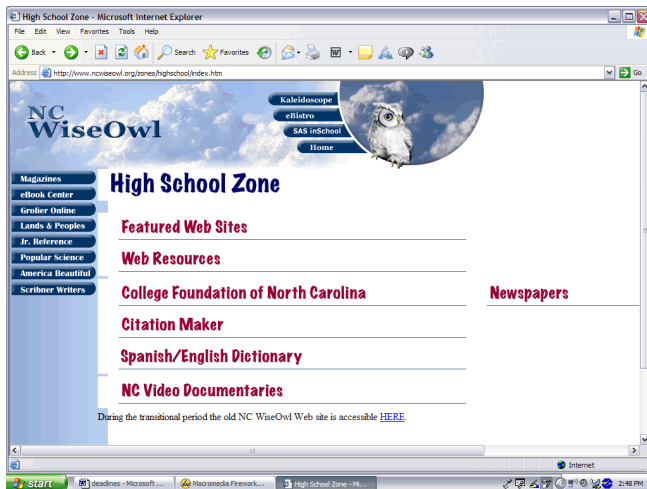
# USING INFOTRAC



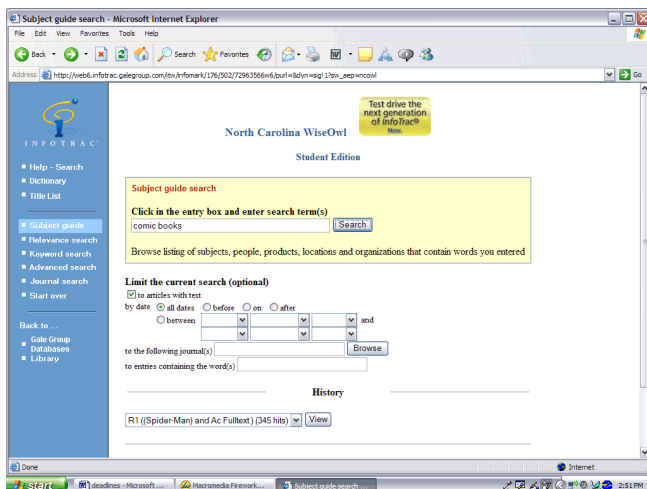
Step 1: type in [www.ncwiseowl.org](http://www.ncwiseowl.org) into your internet browser

click High School Zone

If at any time you are prompted for a password it is: wiseowl



Step 2: click magazine located in the blue column at the left
