Movie Project ~ Choose from your choice of these three:

The Soundtrack:

Pick a song that could be used as a soundtrack to the following scenes. You must include the artist, the name of the song (in quotation marks), the album (underline or italicized), and a description of why that would be a good choice. You may include a few lyrics that you feel are particularly relevant. The rationale for **why** you chose that song is the most important thing.

Here are the scenes:

- The big fight scene at the beginning
- Romeo and Juliet meet at the party
- The secret wedding
- Romeo and Tybalt fight
- Romeo / Juliet alone and apart from each other
- The suicide scene

Extra credit if you can name a composer that could do the instrumental background music when the other songs are not playing. You must include his/her name, some soundtracks they have composed, and why you think they would be a good choice for a soundtrack like this.

The Casting:

Cast the following characters. You must include a picture of the actor/actress, his/her name, a movie that he/she has starred in, and why you think that they would be a good person to play that part. It is the reasoning why that person fit that part that is the most important thing.

Here are the parts:

- Romeo
- Juliet
- The Nurse
- Mercutio
- Tybalt
- Lord Capulet

Extra credit if you can name a director, tell some other movies that person has directed, and explain what qualities that person has that makes him / her a good choice for this movie.

The Movie Poster

Create a poster for the movie. It can be drawn or created on the computer. It needs to capture the viewer's interest and make them excited to see the movie. You need to explain six things that you used in the poster and show their symbolic nature or their significance. It is this explanation that is most important to this grade. If you can't put six things into the poster, you may also design an alternate poster to cover the rest.

Extra Credit

You may do any two of these. The first one goes into your test average. The second one will go in as either 4 class work grades or 3 quizzes, whichever will help you out the most.
